

Wine Name Significance	<p>Maula is a typical word of Argentina, used by the poet Celedonio Flores in the verses of his famous tango song "Mano a mano", he greatest hit of Carlos Gardel in his entire career. The writer, who also was a boxing champion, incurred in the artistic use of the street language of Buenos Aires therefore initiating a tradition among lyricists. This label recreates his celebrated phrase that marked the story of tango: "like the maula cat plays with the miserable mouse..."</p>
