Property Summary	Castell del Remei is a unique chateau style wine cellar founded in 1780. In fact, it was the first Spanish winery to produce Cabernet and Semillon blanc wines, to bottle and label the wines and the first ageing its wines in Catalonia. The estate is located in the province of Lleida, in Western Catalonia, and consists of 120 hectares/296.52 acres dedicated to vines, with an average age of 20 years old. Castell del Remei currently exports to about 50 countries worldwide. The estate of Castell del Remei has several buildings that used to be inhabited by more than 50 families. Among them is worth to mention the Castle, the church devoted to the virgin of Remei, the Restaurant open to the public, the cellars and other like the olive oil mill dated 1793, the flour mill, the old distillery, the barrel workshop etc.
